Subject: Extension of Validity of ICT/Batch Test Reports for the Tractors due for Batch test to comply with revised Test Code IS 12207-Aug 2019-reg.

I am directed to convey the approval of the competent authority for **extension of the validity of their existing ICT or Batch Test Reports till 31st of March, 2020** in respect of the tractors which are due for subsequent batch testing, after the implementation of revised **Test Code IS 12207-Aug 2019**. Further, the manufacturers, who have submitted the applications before the date of termination viz; 24.08.2019 of the pre revised test code, for Initial Commercial Testing of their Tractor's Model, but their test samples were not submitted, are allowed to submit their re-declaration & their test Samples complying with revised test code, **before 31st March, 2020**.

Therefore, all the Tractor Manufacturers are advised to obtain the necessary Administrative / Technical Extension to the Test Reports before 31st March, 2020.

This Extension, as above, is allowed to do the required design & developments on the tractors model at the level of the manufacturers to comply with Performance parameters of the Revised Test Code IS 12207-2019.

No further Extension will be given in the above case.
